

Documentation Requested for ADD/ADHD

For ADHD, the documentation must be dated within the last year, on office letterhead, typed and signed by a licensed mental health or medical professional in the area for which the diagnosis is made. In addition, the documentation ADD/ADHD must be mailed or faxed from the medical professional office directly to the Accessibility Resource Office. Hand carried copies will not be accepted.

The documentation must provide:

- Specific diagnosis of ADHD or ADD
- Date of the evaluation
- Method of evaluation or examination
- How the disability would affect the student in an academic setting
- Any possible limiting or negative effects of medication on behavior or cognitive abilities
- Recommendations and the rationale for each accommodation
